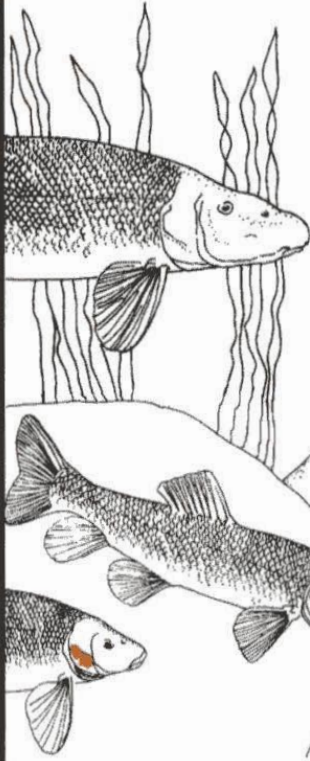

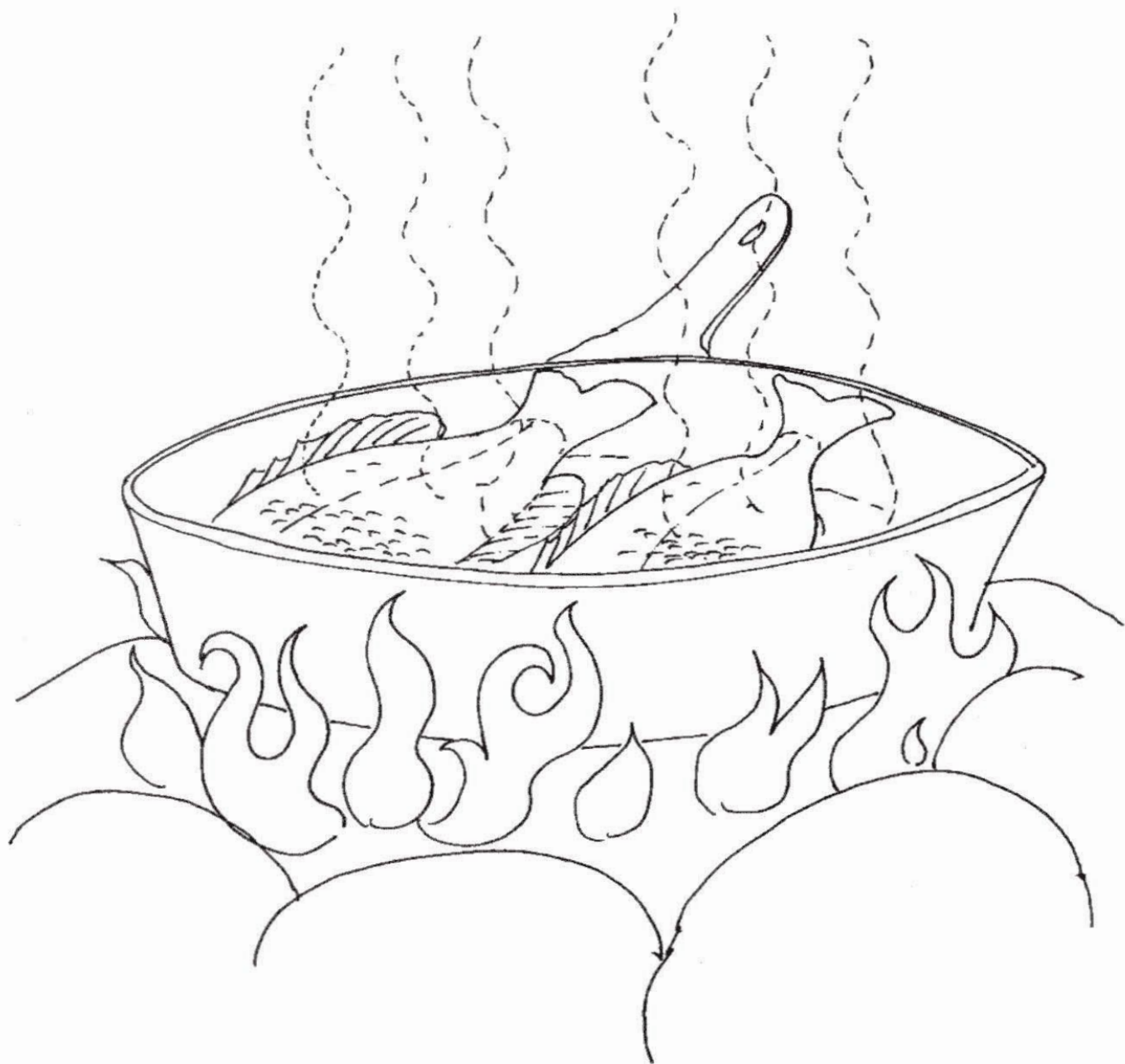

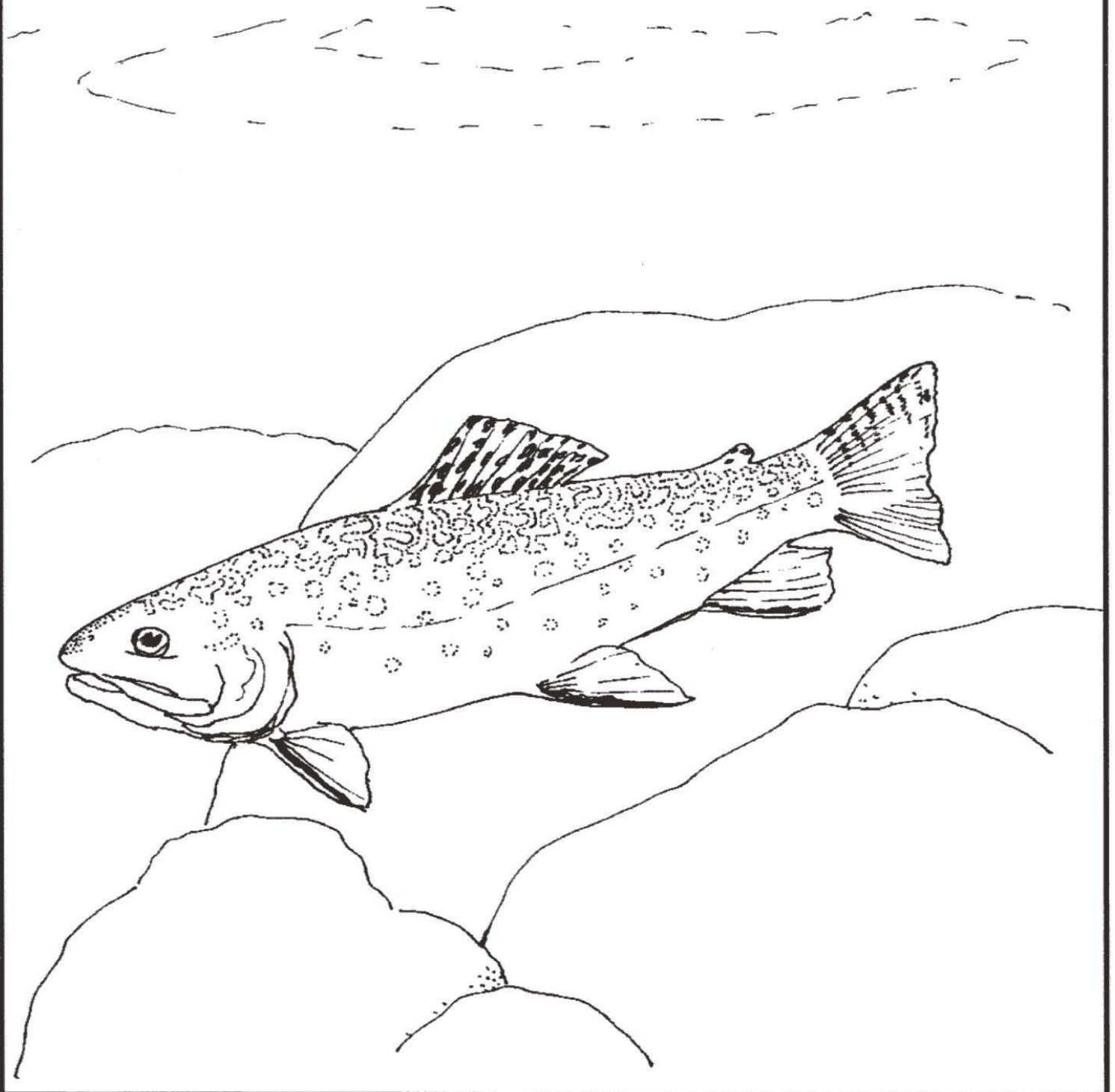
Black Crappie



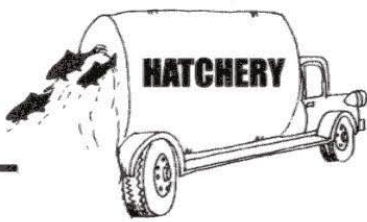
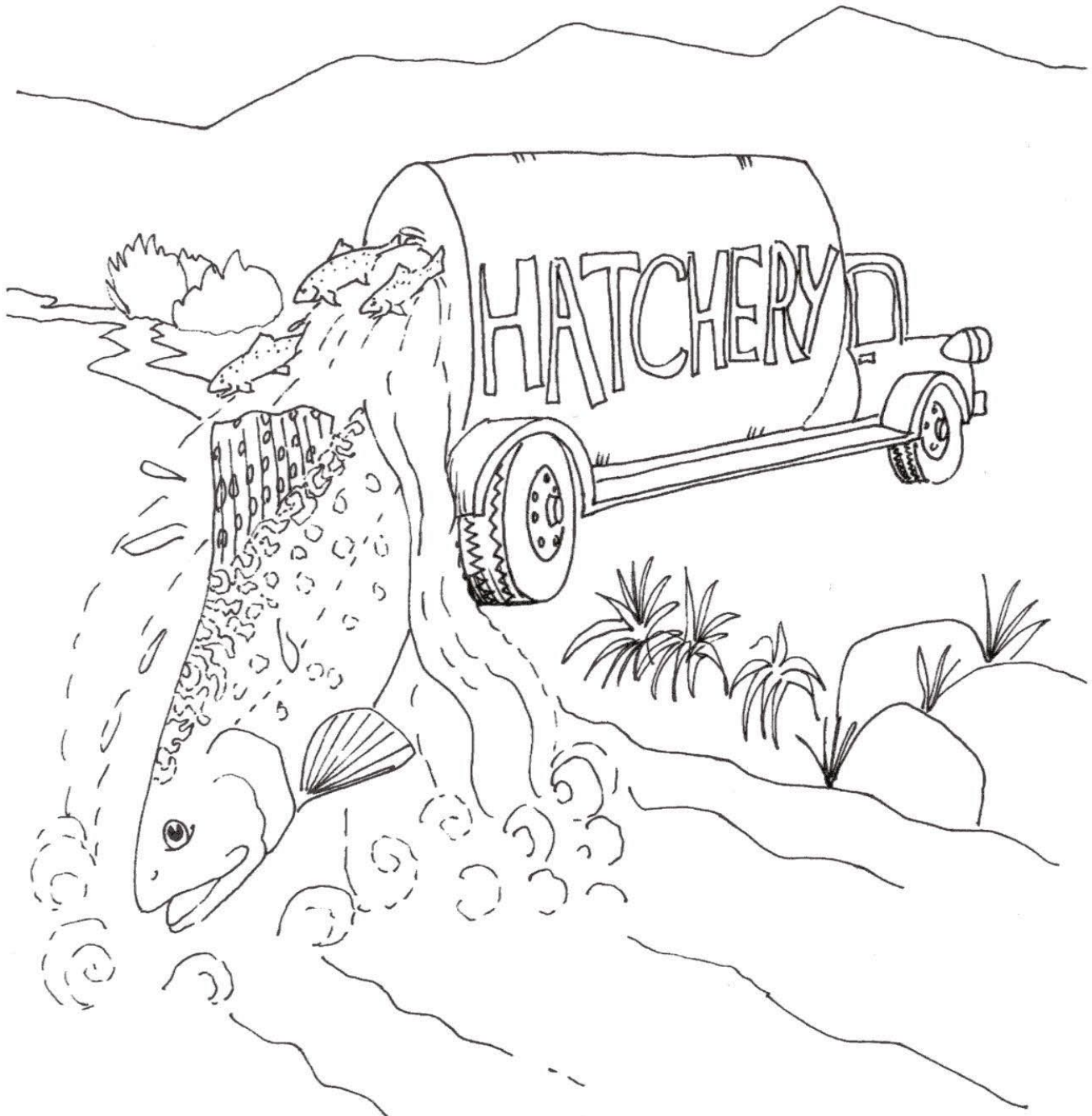
Crappie gobble up smaller fish but they fit perfectly in a pan and are tasty to eat!



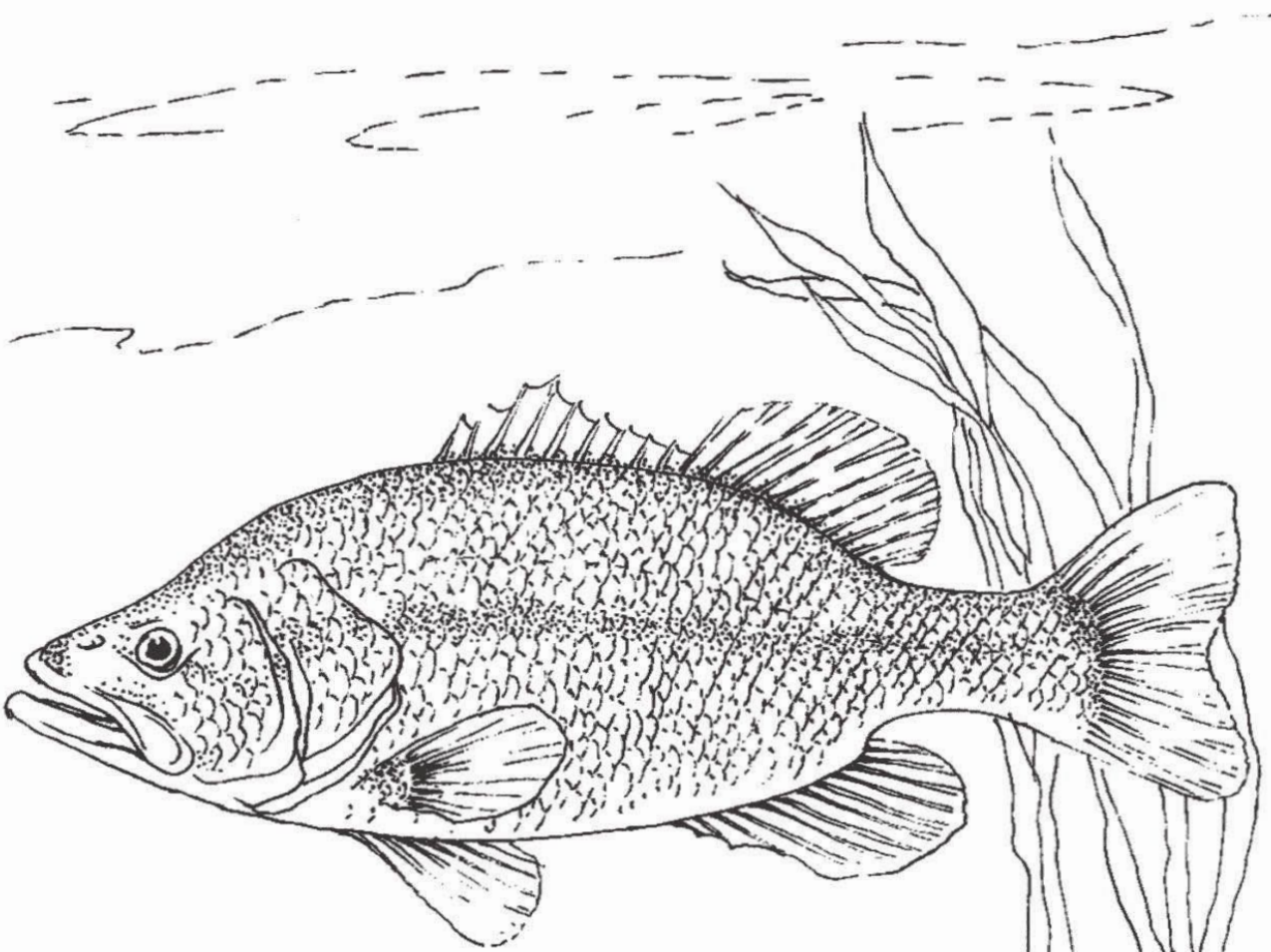
Eastern Brook Trout

types of fish for people to catch.

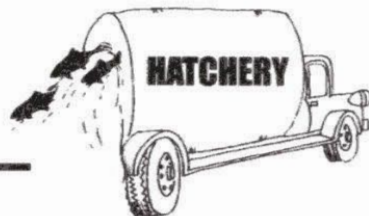


Largemouth Bass

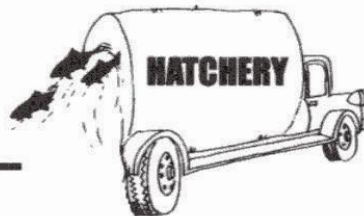
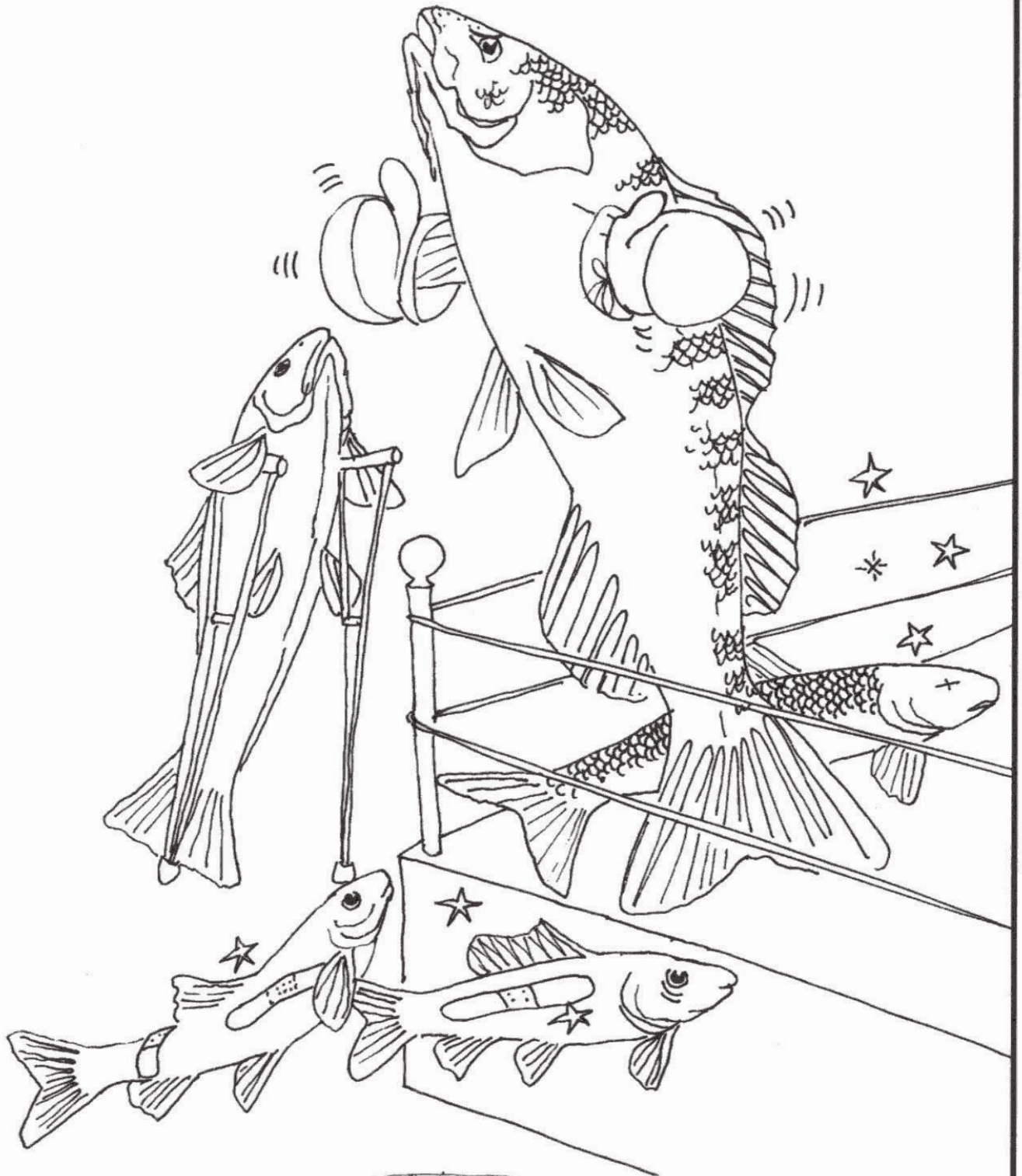


Largemouth bass can be real "meanies"!
